

CHOCORUA SKI & BEACH CLUB SUMMER RULES for: MEMBERS, GUEST & RENTERS

Safety Notice: Please DO NOT FEED the ducks for health reasons.

1. THE BEACH IS OPEN DAILY FOR YOUR PLEASURE AND ENJOYMENT.
2. THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. ALL SWIMMING DONE WITHIN & OUTSIDE OF THE ROPES IS DONE AT YOUR OWN RISK.
3. A SECURITY OFFICER IS ON DUTY WITH VARIED HOURS. HIS DUTIES INCLUDE; CHECKING BEACH PASSES OF MEMBERS OR GUESTS AND HE WILL OVERSEE THAT ANY OF THE RULES LISTED ARE FOLLOWED BY ALL IN A RESPECTFUL MANNER.
4. PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN'S BEHAVIOR & SAFETY. Children 14 and UNDER should be accompanied by an ADULT.
5. NO FISHING IS ALLOWED IN THE DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREAS.
6. SOAP BATHING IS NOT ALLOWED.
7. NO ROUGH HOUSING ON THE RAFTS/DOCKS.
8. MOTORIZED VEHICLES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE BEACH AREA.
9. PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE BEACH BETWEEN 8:00 a.m. & 8:00 p.m. MEMORIAL DAY THRU LABOR DAY. DROPPINGS MUST BE REMOVED BY PET OWNERS. (PETS ARE ALLOWED ONTO YOUR BOAT DURING DAYTIME HOURS)
10. TAKE ALL PERSONAL EQUIPMENT WITH YOU WHEN LEAVING THE BEACH AREA.
11. ALL TODDLERS MUST WEAR SPECIFIC DIAPERS THAT ARE LEAK PROOF AND MADE FOR USE IN THE WATER TO PREVENT BACTERIA FROM CONTAMINATING THE WATER. WE DO HAVE A PORTABLE TOILET IN THE BEACH PARKING LOT.
12. DISPOSAL SERVICE IS NOT PROVIDED. PLEASE TAKE ANY CANS, FLIPTOPS; (THERE IS NO GLASS ALLOWED ON THE BEACH), CIGARETTE BUTTS, BAGS, PAPERS, DIAPERS, ETC. WITH YOU WHEN YOU LEAVE.
13. ONE BOAT PER RESIDENCE IS ALLOWED. STICKERS WILL BE PROVIDED TO IDENTIFY BOATS AND THESE MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE SECURITY OFFICER. BOATS MAY ONLY BE STORED ON YOUR DESIGNATED RACK. BOATS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREAS.
14. THE BEACH GATES CLOSE AT 10:00 PM EACH NIGHT. THEY OPEN AGAIN AT 8 AM. YOU WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARK OUTSIDE THE GATES AFTER 10:00 PM.

CHOCORUA SKI & BEACH WINTER RULES for:

MEMBERS, GUEST & RENTERS

1. BE AWARE of the *culverts / ditches/ drains* on the sides of our streets.
2. To ensure the safety of everyone we ask that you do not ride your snowmobiles or ATV's on the mounds on either side of the roads for you could land in a culvert, ditches or drains.
3. To ensure the safety of everyone we ask that you adhere to the TEN (YES, 10) MPH as the road surface changes quickly due to ice and snow.
4. Due to the nature of the storms, the road plowing crew will plow as soon as storm conditions allow. Please cooperate with them.
5. BEWARE of the POND'S THICKNESS for all Winter Activities: ICE FISHING/SKATING/ SNOWMOBILING
6. When parking cars on the street during snowstorms, please be sure that you park in a safe place.
7. While enjoying your snowmobiles, please be courteous and respectful to other members, guests, renters and their property.

*MEMBERS REMEMBER - When having snowmobile guests or renters during the winter, remind them to be courteous and respectful to members, and other guests and renters.
