MEMORIAL DAY CLEAN-UP/FIREWISE Hear Ye Hear Ye – Come One – Come All

The annual clean-up and Firewise Awareness Day is scheduled for May 28rd from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. with a rain date of May 29th. We encourage anyone who wants to volunteer and meet fellow residents to come down and improve our neighborhood. For those who volunteer, lunch will be provided with a cookout. **The meeting place will be at the basketball court this year at 9:00 a.m.**

We are planning to have campfire permits available and there will be Firewise literature available explaining the program. We look forward to seeing all our members down to the beach on the 28rd to pick up some literature and get their campfire permits.

Lastly, in conjunction with Firewise Awareness Day, the month of **June/July** will be dedicated to bringing brush to the ball field area in order for a contractor to chip brush sometime in July (date to be determined) for **members in good standing who have paid their dues/assessments in full. Brush only and branches no larger than**

3” in diameter. If you add your brush to the pile please plan to help on the date it is all chipped. Bring your rakes and shovels to join the fun, while saving the association money by doing the work ourselves.
