VETERAN'S MEMORIAL BRICKS

The Memorial Park Veteran's Brick project has resulted in an addition of 16 veteran's bricks, (inner circle), and 27 family bricks, (outer circle). The order for this year's Memorial Day

bricks was placed on April 1, to guarantee installation, at the flagpole, by the 2017 Memorial Day Ceremonies.

If you are interested in a veteran's brick, they are 4"x 9" & may have 3 lines for name, rank, date, site of service & military insignia. There is no charge for veteran's bricks. Family bricks are the same size, with the same limitations of 3 lines of text & an insignia of your choice. Family bricks are \$25.00 each.
